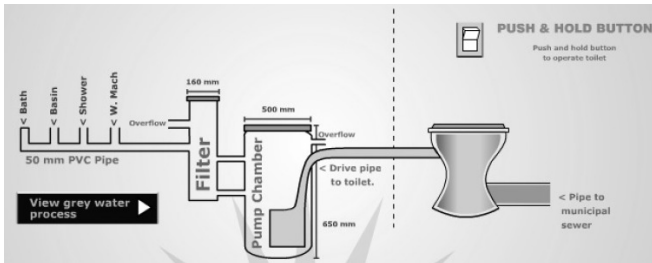


SECOND MOVEMENT

If you can't irrigate with grey water, you can still make a contribution to re-using grey water by using that water for flushing your toilet.



Grey water is stored in a semi submerged chamber in the ground. This grey water is pumped directly into the toilet pan without the need for any toilet cistern. Instead of the cistern, all you see is a bell push, which starts the flush, but as soon as you release the bell push, the flushing stops. The bell push is 12 volt so is quite safe to use without any possibility of getting shocked by the use of electricity in the bathroom.

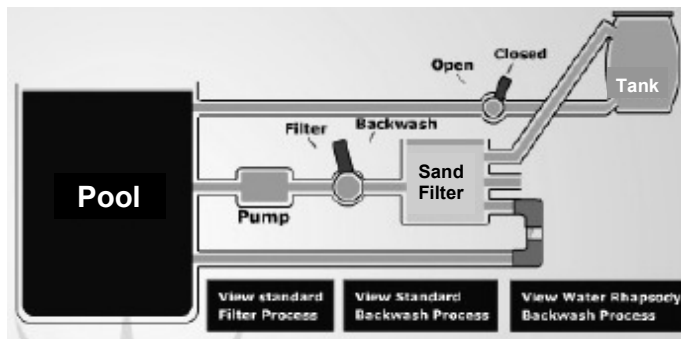
Saving: In houses without gardens or flats, the volume of water saved is 40% or more.



POOLSIDE TANK


Stop throwing your pool backwash away! It is illegal to pump this water to the street, and environmentally most unfriendly.

Our system receives the water normally thrown away from a pool's filter backwash process. The system processes this dirty water, and within 24 hours, the water can be safely returned to the pool.

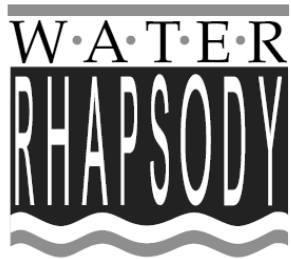

GARDEN RHAPSODY

Irrigate your garden with grey water, which is usually discarded down the drain.

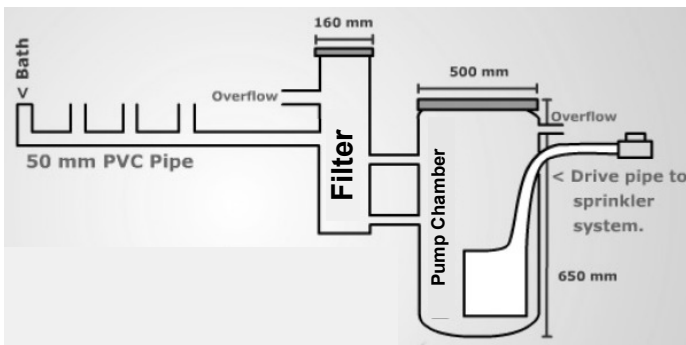
Grey Water is defined as: ‘water from your bath, shower, clothes washing machine and hand basins’.

This water is diverted via the filter into the pump chamber, from where it is automatically pumped along a hose pipe and sprinkled onto your garden via a pyramid sprinkler.

‘Irrigate with grey water’.

This means that while you are taking a shower your garden is simultaneously irrigated.

Our Garden Rhapsody system is a very cost effective way of conserving water. Average saving: up to 35% on your water use.

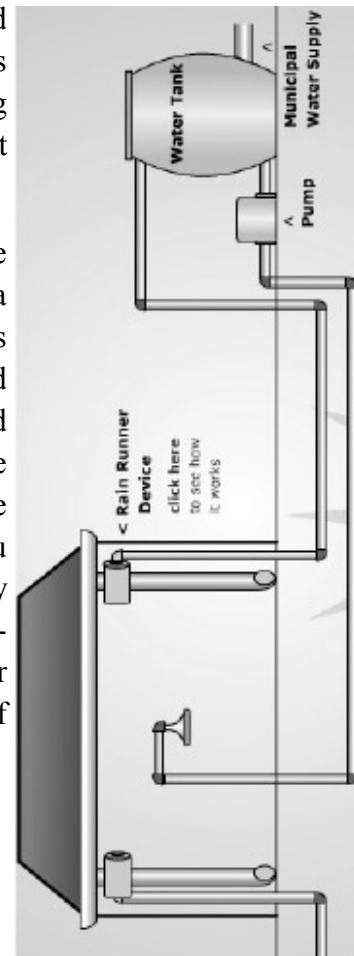


GRAND OPUS & UPWS

(uninterrupted pressurized water supply)

The Water Rhapsody Rain Runner will divert and sieve rain water from a roof. To prevent blockages in a reduced pipe. The debris is sent to waste along with a small amount of water.

Clean water from the Rain Runner fills a water tank, and this water can be pumped to the entire household reducing dependence on main supply. The UPWS guarantees you water at all times by allowing the introduction of mains water should you run out of rain water.

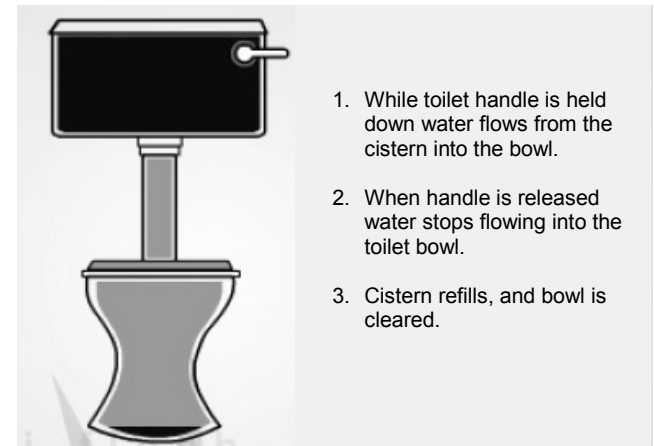


Printed on environmentally friendly paper made from farmed trees. Minimal water is used in the environmentally friendly ECF bleaching process.



MULTI FLUSH

This device replaces the flushing mechanism in your toilet. In doing so, it allows you to flush manually, holding the flushing handle for as long as you require. Releasing the flushing han-



dle simply stops the flushing of water. This means that you use the least amount of water required to clear the pan.

Savings on your water bill could exceed 20%, but far higher in the amount paid for water considering the price paid for water as well as for sewerage effluent.
